



ADJUSTER GEAR CHECKLIST

- A Reliable Vehicle
- Smart Phone (& portable charger)
- Laptop & Printer
- Digital Camera w/ 2 SD Cards
- Ladder (that fits in vehicle)
- Tape Measure (incl. laser)
- Clipboard and graph paper
- Shingle Gauge (HAAG, incl. metal roof gauge)
- Pitch (Slope) Gauge
- Chalk (both light & dark colors)
- Voice Recorder
- Moisture Meter
- Cougar Paws (incl. replacement pads)
- Rubber Boots
- Tool Belt
- Atlas Nitrile Gloves (I swear by them!)
- Basket for gear
- Small Ice Chest
- Hat & Sunglasses (Roof claims get intense)
- File Folder w/ printed documents
- Hammer & Crowbar
- GPS (most smart phones will do just fine)
- Rope & Harness (certification required)
- Comfortable Clothes (Polo, Khakis, Appropriate Shoes)



REMINDER:

You do not need to purchase everything on this entire list.

Start from the top, which are the most important items, and work your way down.

If you are a staff adjuster, you will most likely be provided these items.

As an independent adjuster, you will most likely be required to have majority of these items.

If you plan to be a CAT adjuster, I would recommend all of these items well before storm season.
